Please tell us how you considered the guidance set forth in Question 102.10 of the Division's Compliance and Disclosure Interpretations on Non-GAAP Financial Measures, which can be found on our website at <a href="http://www.sec.gov/divisions/corpfin/guidance/nongaapinterp.htm">http://www.sec.gov/divisions/corpfin/guidance/nongaapinterp.htm</a>, when making your presentation. Otherwise, please confirm that you will remove the non-GAAP statements of operations from your future presentations.

We urge all persons who are responsible for the accuracy and adequacy of the disclosure in the filing to be certain that the filing includes the information the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and all applicable Exchange Act rules require. Since the company and its management are
