## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Registration Statement on Form S-8 (the “Registration Statement”) is being filed for the purpose of registering an additional 1,400,000 shares of common stock, \$0.01 par value per share (the “Common Stock”), of Avid Technology, Inc. (the “Company”), which have been authorized and reserved for issuance under the Avid Technology, Inc. Amended and Restated 2014 Stock Incentive Plan. Accordingly, the contents of the Company’s registration statements on Form S-8 filed with the SEC on May 30, 2018 (File No. 333- 225279), June 12, 2017 (File No. 333-218677) and November 12, 2014 (File No. 333-200139) are incorporated by reference into this Registration Statement pursuant to General Instruction E of Form S-8.
